About Congresswoman Barbara Lee

Congresswoman Barbara Lee has been representing California's 13th District since 1998. She is the highest ranking African American woman in Democratic Leadership, serving as Co-Chair of the Policy and Steering Committee. She also serves on the Budget Committee and the powerful Appropriations Committee, which oversees all federal government spending. Congresswoman Lee began her career in politics as a volunteer on Congresswoman Shirley Chisholm's 1972 presidential campaign after meeting her as a student at Mills College. Congresswoman Chisholm was a mentor to Congresswoman Lee throughout her career and encouraged her to run for office.

About Angela Yee

Award-winning media personality Angela Yee currently co-hosts Power 105.1's nationally syndicated radio show *The Breakfast Club*. Over the past 11 years, the trio's undeniable impact on the culture has garnered several accolades including their induction into the Radio Hall of Fame in 2020. Outside of media, Angela has tapped into her entrepreneurial spirit with several endeavors centered around giving back to her community and providing access to nutrition, financial literacy, education, and culture. In

2018, the New York City mayor officially designated August 28th as Angela Yee Day. Yee's two-decade career has solidified her as this generation's "go-to" media personality.
